3. Minimum weight and scrotal circumference:
 - Yearlings 220 pounds and 32 centimeters
 - Lambs 120 pounds and 30 centimeters
4. All animals must be bred and owned by the seller.

5. Registration papers and the cost of transfer are strictly between the buyer and seller.
 6. All rams will be guaranteed breeders (ram lambs are not subject to guarantee in year of purchase). The guarantee is between buyer and seller.
 7. Health papers will be available for out-of-state buyers.
 8. The catalog is arranged in sale order with ram first followed by ewe entries.
 9. Phone bids will be accepted by the Sales Committee and NDLWPA board members. See numbers below.

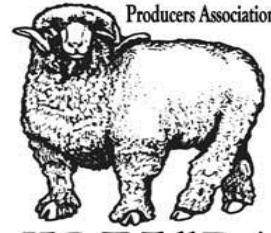
