- 2. All rams must originate from flocks that have been inspected and found free of foot rot.
- 3. Minimum weight and scrotal circumference:
  - Yearlings 220 pounds and 32 centimeters
  - Lambs 120 pounds and 30 centimeters
- 4. All animals must be bred and owned by the seller.
- 5. Registration papers and the cost of transfer are strictly between the buyer and seller.
- 6. All rams will be guaranteed breeders (ram lambs are not subject to guarantee in year of purchase). The guarantee is between buyer and seller.
- 7. Health papers will be available for out-of-state buyers.
- 8. The catalog is arranged in the sales order by breeds, then individual breeders. Ewes will sell first, then the rams. Ewes will be sold at gate cut.
- 9. Phone bids will be accepted by the Sale Committee and NDLWPA board members. See numbers below.
